The UPHSL Main Library celebrated the 82nd National Book Week last November 23-25, 2016 with a series of activities aligned to the theme: *Today's Readers: Inclusivity in Diversity*.

To started the event (November 23), with a Mass, Inauguration of STARBOOKS and Opening Ceremony were held. This was followed in the afternoon by a training-STARBOOKS attended by library staff, all students and some faculty members of the university. The trainer was Ms. Robelyn M. Cruz, Science Research Specialist II from Science and Technology Information Institute (STII). During the training, Dr. Elizabeth D. Malabanan, Director of Libraries accepted the book donations together with Mr. Flynn, representative from Beacon Academy.
