The Picture Imaginative Materials and the Creative Writing Skills of Grade 10 Students of University of Perpetual Help System Laguna

Abstract

Creative writing is anything where the purpose is to express the thoughts, feelings and emotions rather than simply convey information. Hence, other view creative writing as being able to produce noble works in writing; working on one's own imagination and putting it on a piece of paper to create an exceptional good and interesting literature. Pictures, postcards, charts and even wordless picture books offer a wonderful foundation of creative writing. It offers a platform for the students to develop their writing skills. But how does a picture imaginative material make an individual creative writing?

Is there a significant difference in the creative writing skills of the respondents' in poem when exposed and not exposed to picture imaginative materials? 4. Is there a significant difference in the creative writing skills of the respondents' in essay when exposed and not exposed to picture imaginative materials? The study utilized the experimental method of research where the study respondents were classified as to controlled and experimental group.
