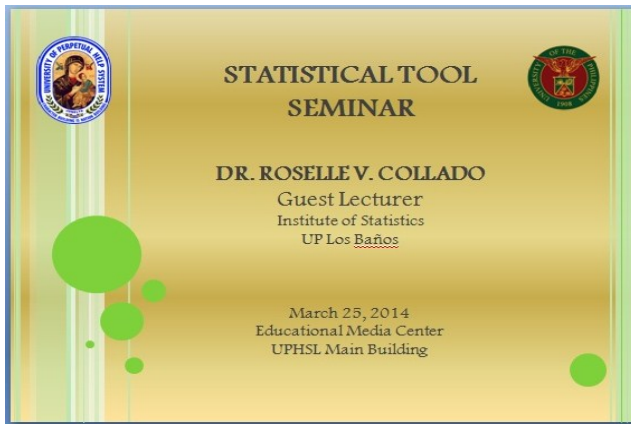


**Newly trained Statisticians in SPSS review Basic Statistical Methods**
