Predictors of CPA Board Performance: A Five-Year Retrospective Study

Abstract

This study determined the predictors of Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Board performance among Bachelor of Science in Accountancy (BSA) graduates of the University of Perpetual Help System Laguna. The study sample were 70 graduates who took the CPA Licensure Examinations from 2008 to 2012. The study utilized the descriptive correlational research design. The researcher used documentary analysis in data gathering for this retrospective study. Specifically, the study determined the participants' types of high school attended, their grades in High School, general education courses such as Math, English and Science, in Major and Professional courses, college grade point average (GPA) as well as on-the-job training (OJT) and the correlations of these variables with the participants' performance in the CPA Licensure Examination. The results showed that all variables were moderately correlated with the CPA Board performance. However, only the grades in High
