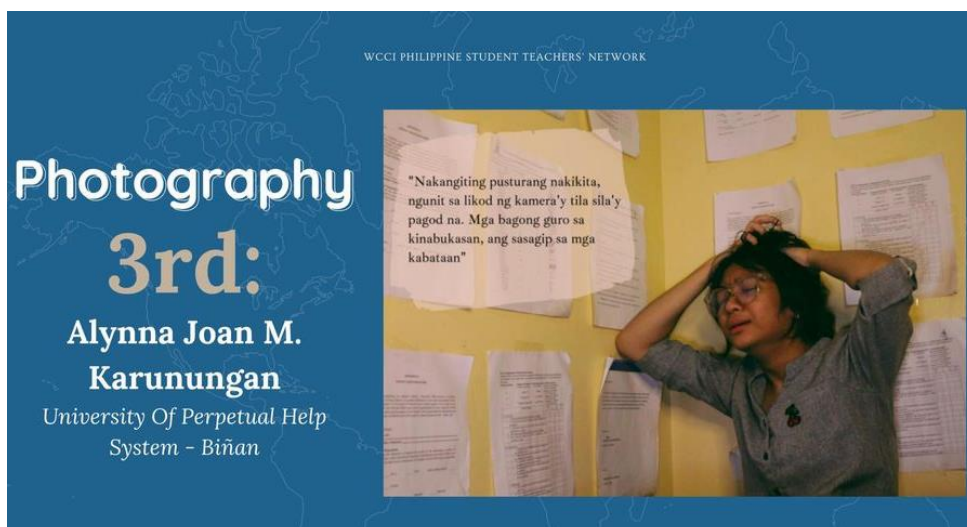
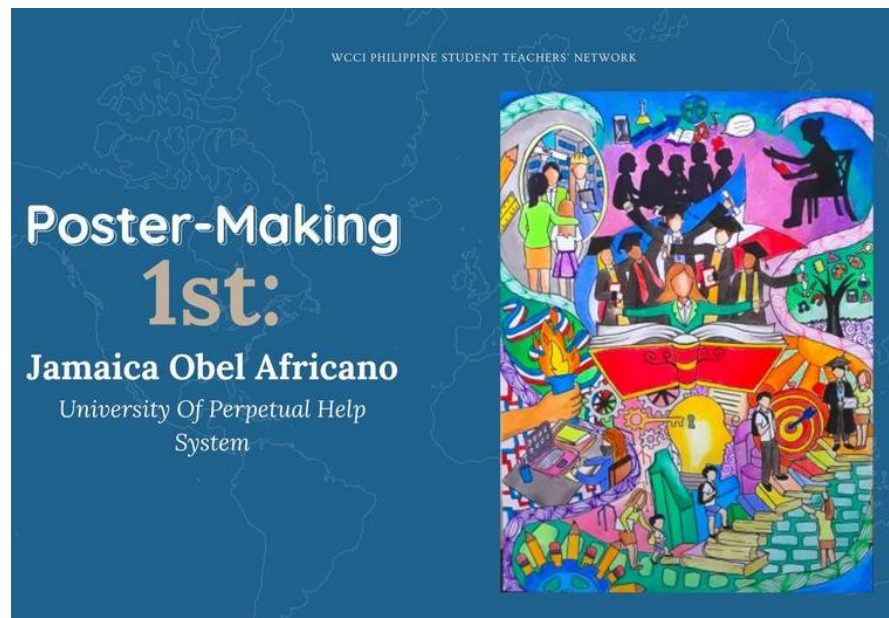


Entries for Teacher Month Celebration Won
